

# THE WINES OF THE CHATEAU / AOC VENTOUX

## SINGLE VINEYARDS



**ASCENSIO**  
CLAY & LIMESTONE

**GRENACHE (95%), SYRAH (5%)**  
With 30% whole cluster only aged in cement tank, bright and powerful.



**ARTEMIA**  
LIMESTONE GRAVEL

**SYRAH (80%), GRENACHE (20%)**  
Violet flower, graphite flavours and a brightness which reminds the great syrah from the North of the Rhône Valley.

**SILICA**  
SANDY TERROIR

**GRENACHE (90%), CINSAULT (10%)**  
Elegance and finesse of the grenache planted on a sandy soil.



## ALTITUDE AND COOL MICROCLIMATE

Located at the foot of Mont Ventoux (1912 m), the vineyard enjoys a cool microclimate:

- Cool nights thanks to the elevation 300-400m (1000-1300 feet) and the influence of the Alps;
- The exceptional sunshine of Mediterranean area;
- The latest-ripening terroir of the southern Rhone Valley.

## ORGANIC & BIODYNAMIC

From sustainable farming, Château Pesquié has moved to organic in the 2000's;  
First plots certified organic (Ecocert) in 2007;  
Biodynamic practices start in 2015 and are validated in the vineyard by Demeter in 2019.




## A RICH GEOLOGICAL CROSSROAD,

This unique terroir offers a rare diversity of soils:



- Limestone - for freshness (whites and reds);
- Clay - for structure (reds);
- Sand - for finesse (rosés, reds);
- Blue Marl - strength & balance (reds);



## JULIETTE

**CLAIRETTE (70%), GRENACHE BLANC (30%),**  
Salty notes and bright minerality.



## QUINTESSENCE

### ROSE

**MOURVEDRE (70%), CINSAULT (20%), CLAIRETTE (10%)**

Gastronomic rosé with great texture and length.

### RED

**SYRAH (80%), GRENACHE (20%)**  
Beautiful structure, volume and power, silky tannins.

### WHITE

**ROUSSANNE (80%), CLAIRETTE (20%)**  
Chalky soils minerality. Roundness, balance and good length.

## TERRASSES



**RED / GRENACHE (60%), SYRAH (40%)**

Blend of all our terroirs. Precise, elegant, smooth and fresh. Improves during its first years.

**WHITE / VIOGNIER (25%), GRENACHE BLANC (25%), ROUSSANNE (25%), CLAIRETTE (25%)**

Chalky, stony soils. Delicate flavors of citrus and white flowers.

**ROSE / CINSAULT (50%), GRENACHE (40%), SYRAH (10%)**

Sand and chalky soils. Bright pale rosé, mineral, floral and fruit forward.
